# This program begins with YOU!

Park Family Connections is a group of caring individuals and organizations working together to help children and families in Park County become stronger, happier and at peace, by helping coordinate their care.

## How to get started:

Once referred to the program by a community partner, a coordinator will spend time learning about you and your family and help you identify unique strengths and needs.

The coordinator will help guide you in the creation of your family's support team, which includes people you choose: family, friends, professionals and anyone else who has been supportive or helpful to you and your family.



At a collaborative team meeting, a plan will be created that is intended to help meet your family's goals.

The coordinator will meet regularly with you and your team to determine what is working and what is not. The plan can be adjusted anytime you see it is necessary.

## Components of SUCCESS

1. Commitment to the process
2. Willingness to participate
3. Complete multiple agency release forms
4. Maintain open communication
5. Commitment to follow-through
